

Fully compliant with IMO Guidelines, ABS e-Certificates will reduce administrative burdens and simplify Flag State verification.

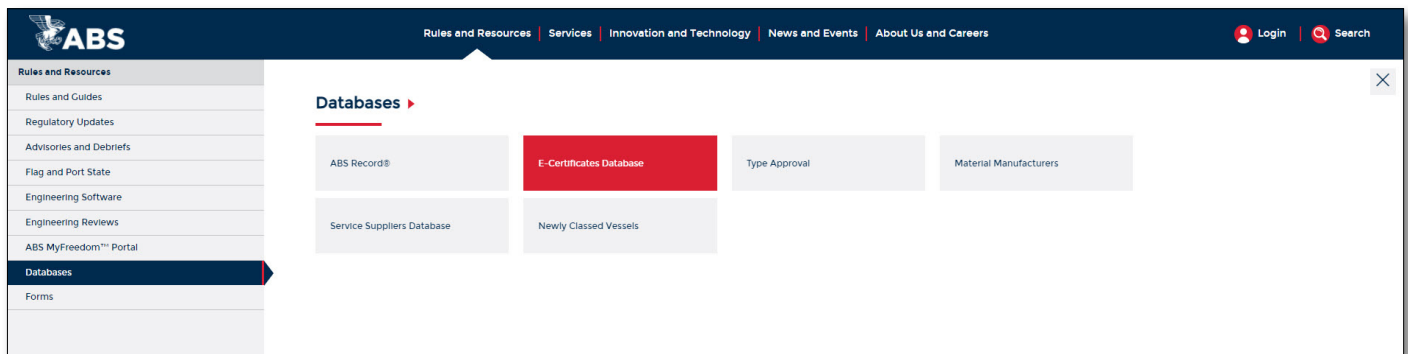
ABS has established a public site where anyone can look up and validate any ABS e-Certificate in accordance with IMO FAL.5 Circ.39/Rev. 2 requirements, either by the vessel IMO number or the certificate number.

## PUBLIC ACCESS FOR QUICK VALIDATION OF E-CERTIFICATES

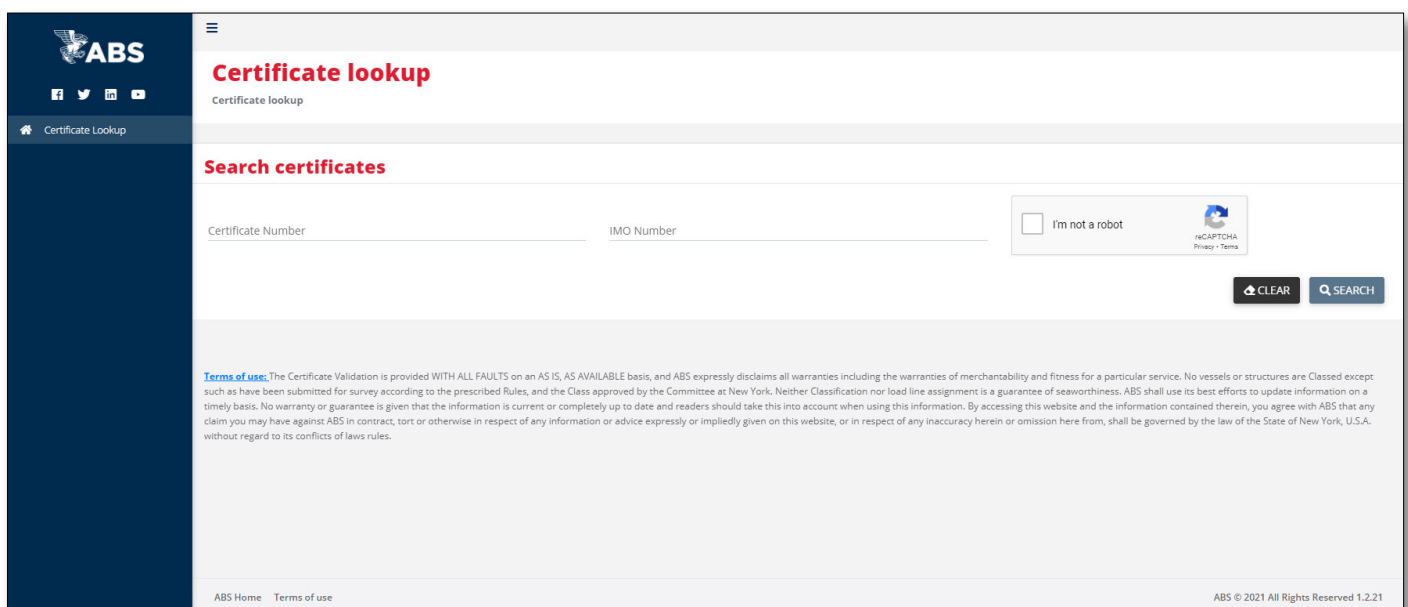
The authenticity, originality and traceability of the e-Certificates are easily verifiable.

### HOW TO VALIDATE AN E-CERTIFICATE

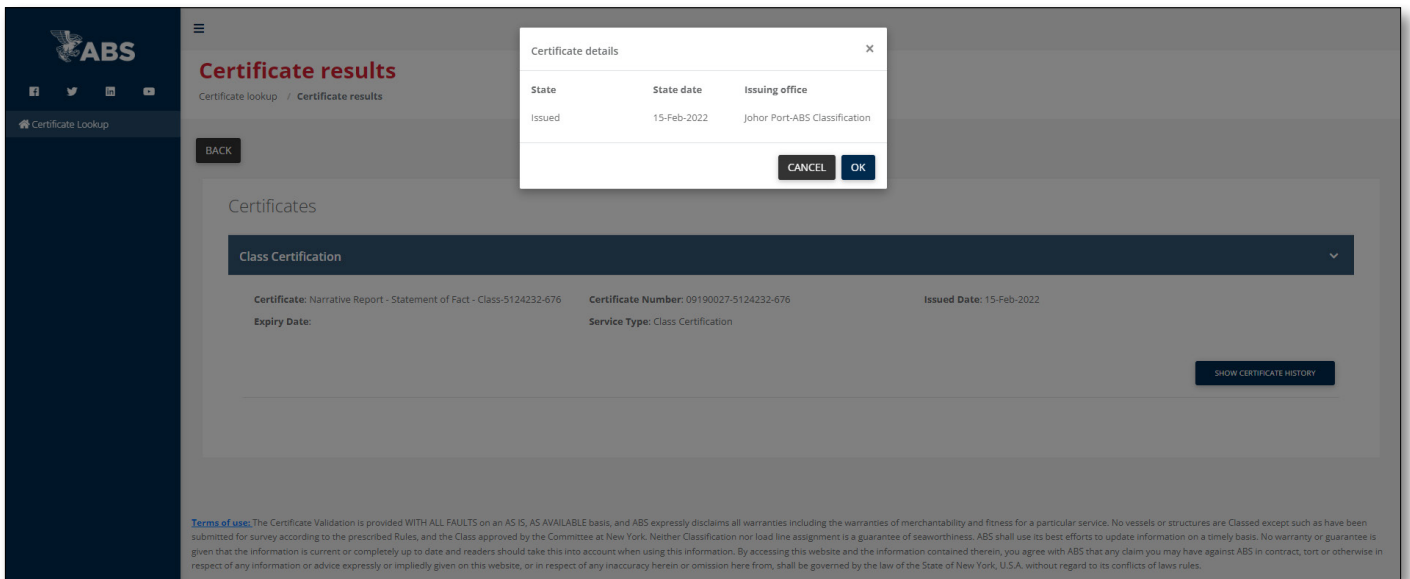
1. Go to [www.eagle.org](http://www.eagle.org) and navigate to Rules and Resources → Databases → E-Certificates Database. For direct access visit [www.eagle.org/portal/#/certificate\\_lookup/search](http://www.eagle.org/portal/#/certificate_lookup/search).



2. Enter the IMO Number or ABS Certificate Number.



- The general certificate information will be displayed, and the certificate history can be chosen to display issuance and endorsement dates. In the event that a certificate is not authentic or valid an alert message will be displayed.



This verifies that the e-certificate meets IMO FAL.5 Circ.39/Rev.2 requirements, and has not been altered since issuance.
